

Delighted to give away 39,440 books in 2013

Each year EPM gives away thousands of books to organizations and individuals for ministry needs. This was an especially significant year for book giveaways with the release of Randy's *Eternity* graphic novel. Because the book clearly contains the gospel and targets a different audience than his other books, we were excited about the outreach potential. We offered multiple copies to prison chaplains and Christian ministries such as Youth for Christ and Cru Military Connection, resulting in over 3,500 copies of *Eternity* given away.

One prisoner wrote, "This comic book is so cool! I opened it and couldn't stop reading!" We are continuing to pray that many more readers of *Eternity* will enter into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

EPM publishes two books by Randy

Randy's books are one of the most important aspects of our teaching ministry. In 2013, we published two of his titles both in print and in ebook format. Our hope is that these books will not only encourage readers, but also provide a source of funding for our ministry.

Randy thoroughly revised and updated *Help for Women Under Stress: Preserving Your Sanity*, which he originally wrote in 1986 with his wife Nanci. "Easy to read and full of truths that I desperately needed to be reminded of," wrote one reader. *Seeing the Unseen: A Daily Dose of Eternal Perspective* is a 60-day devotional that offers insights from Randy on a variety of topics related to the Christian life, along with Scriptures and inspirational quotes.


Encouraging and impacting pastors

Some of the projects EPM supported in 2013

Dalit Freedom Network: Schooling for Dalit Children

The Dalits in India are history's longest standing oppressed people group. Because their children face discrimination and abuse in government schools, the Dalit Freedom Network operates over 100 Dalit Education Centers throughout India. Nearly 30% of the 25,000 children receiving education at these centers have parents who are bonded laborers, so the education they receive helps them escape the poverty that puts them at risk for commercial sexual exploitation, forced labor, or bonded labor.



The Guardian Project: Mobile Ultrasound Unit



EPM supported the Guardian Project's efforts to raise the startup costs associated with purchasing and operating the first ever mobile ultrasound unit in Oregon to reach abortion-minded moms. This mobile unit, which will be operational in early 2014, will focus on the areas of Portland, Oregon where there are currently no alternative pregnancy resource centers for women.



ALARM: Training in South Sudan

ALARM is an African-led and Africanbased organization that focuses on equipping leaders by training them in biblical theology, conflict resolution, mediation, and leadership skills. EPM supported a trauma healing and recovery training for local staff in South Sudan.



Compassion First: Rescuing Survivors of Trafficking

Compassion First provides frontline, hope-filled solutions for survivors of child sexual trafficking. With a desire to work in regions not already served by other organizations, their flagship effort is in Indonesia. They provide residential and community-based aftercare, legal advocacy, and human rights services. EPM supported Compassion First's Rescue Fund, which provides funding to pay for interventions on behalf of children trapped in forced prostitution.

The *Eternity* graphic novel has opened up new avenues for ministry. In September, Randy attended Portland's Rose City Comic Con to share the book and its message. He writes, "I really enjoyed sharing both the *Eternity* graphic novel and the gospel with lots of folks. Praying God will touch the hearts of people I spoke with." Randy, EPM staff member Julia Stager, and some volunteers will be attending another Comic Con in January 2014.

Randy's writing projects and future books

Randy spent a significant portion of 2013 working on his next book, a theology of happiness, which is expected out in spring of 2015. He writes, "It centers on the large group of biblical words that include gladness, joy, happiness, delight, merriment, celebrating, feasting, etc. One of the goals is to correct the misguided notion that joy is spiritual and deep and not an emotion, while happiness is secular and shallow and emotional...as if emotion is bad, and God doesn't want us to be happy. The truth is much richer and far broader. God, who is Himself infinitely happy, has indeed called us to eternal happiness and celebration that begins here and now. There's a lot more, but that's an important part of it."

Randy also wrote the manuscript for his next graphic novel, which will tell the life story of the Apostle Paul and is due out in 2014.


EPM's greatest need in 2014
